**ENGLISH MAJOR SELECTION TEST (EMSET), 2025**

**INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES FOR CANDIDATES**

- The Selection Test for English Core (Major) will be held in the offline mode on Tuesday, **20 th May, 2025**.
- The Test will be held from **10:30 am to 12:30 pm** in the **J.B. College Commerce Campus**.
- Seating arrangement will be posted at the venue on the day of the Selection Test.
- The General/OBC category candidates who have secured a minimum of **65% marks in aggregate** and **75% General English in their 10+2 Final Examinations** will be eligible to sit for the Selection Test.
- Eligibility criteria for SC/ST/DA category candidates will be **60%marks in aggregate and 70% in General English**.
- The written Selection Test will comprise a single Question Paper of 60 marks which must be completed in two hours.
- **Merit Lists will be prepared on the basis of an 80-mark band, of which 75% (60 marks) will be taken from the EMSET written test, and 25% (20 marks) will be calculated on the basis of 10+2 Aggregate marks.**
- Candidates are also directed to bring along:
  - a) a photo ID document (Adhaar Card/PAN card/ Driving License/EPIC)
  - b) a copy of the **Admit Card** from their last 10+2 examination.
  - c) a copy the **10+2 Final Examination Mark Sheet**
  - d) a print-out of the **SAMARTH registration No. / Unique ID number** and
  - e) a **copy of the relevant caste certificate** in case of application against reserved seats.
- Candidates shall write their a) 10+2 **ADMIT CARD Number** b) **SAMARTH REGISTRATION Number** c) **Category** d) **Marks in English\*** and d) **Aggregate Marks\*** on their answer script.
- **Candidates should not write their NAME anywhere.**
- **Mobile phones and smart watches are strictly prohibited.** Candidates are liable to be **expelled / rejected** if any of these objects is found in their possession.
- Candidates should read the Question Paper carefully and answer, so far as possible, in **their own words**.
