NOTICE

- In partial modification of the earlier Notice Ref No. JBU/DAC/Res/26/9 dated 23.05.2026, and as per decision of the first Academic Council (AC) of Jagannath Barooah University, held on 29.5.2026, and subsequently approved by the first Executive Council (EC) held on 5.6.2026, both the **FYUGP Bachelor's Degree with Honours** and the **Honours with Research Degree** pathways will be open for students, with the **Honours with Research** pathway being operationalized for eligible students **only in departments with adequate infrastructure, equipment, and human resources** in consonance with NEP 2020 norms.
- Further, in partial modification of the earlier Notice Ref No. JBU/DAC/Res/26/9 dated 23.05.2026, and as per directions received from the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Jagannath Barooah University, students currently in the sixth semester, FYUGP, with or without academic arrears /backlog courses, will be allowed to progress to the seventh semester to pursue **Degree with Honours**, provided that this be regarded as a one-time concession offered only for the benefit of students who have appeared in the sixth semester final examination in May, 2026 and that further decisions in this regard may be taken and revisions made by the University Authority as and when required.
- The basic criteria for entry into **Degree with Research** in the seventh semester shall continue to be as per recommendations of the National Higher Education Qualification Framework (NHEQF).
- Parallel admissions through the SAMARTH portal into the **two-year Post Graduate Programme (Non-NEP)** offered by designated departments for the eligible students completing three years of FYUGP / CBCS programme from other institutions also, which will continue to run as **Self Financing Courses (SFC)**, as in the past.
- Selection criteria for students seeking entry into **two-year Post Graduate Programme (Non-NEP SFC)** will be on the basis of **merit / selection tests** conducted by the concerned departments, as in the past and subject to the availability of seats.

- **Lateral entry** for students from other institutions into the Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) will be possible provided (i) the applicants are found to have earned a minimum of 132 credits at the end of their first six semesters and (ii) the applicants have earned a minimum percentage of 70% marks or their equivalent cumulative grade points on completion of six semesters; iii) the department applied for does not offer the two-year Post Graduate Degree; iv) there is availability of seats.
