

NOTICE- IV FOR HOSTEL ADMISSION, ACADEMIC SESSION 2026-27

Applications for admission to the JB University hostels for the academic session 2026–27 are hereby invited from PG Semester-I students admitted to J.B. University. Applications may be submitted from 14 August to 17 August 2026. The list of selected candidates will be published on 18 August 2026.

Applicants are required to submit the prescribed information along with the necessary supporting documents through the following Google Form:

Please Note:

1. Eligibility for Hostel Admission

- The permanent residential address of an applicant must be at least 30 km away from Jagannath Barooah University. Preference shall be given to applicants residing outside Jorhat district.

2. Submission of Applications

- Applications must be submitted within the prescribed period. No application shall be accepted after the last date of submission, and no request or claim in this regard shall be entertained.
- Applicants who have not opted for a hostel seat on the Samarth portal must do so when the facility becomes available on the portal.

3. Selection Criteria

Hostel admission shall be granted on the basis of:

- Academic performance in UG Final Examination;
- Distance between the applicant's permanent residence and Jagannath Barooah University, Jorhat.

4. Verification of Documents

- All submitted mark sheets and supporting documents shall be verified. Submission of incorrect, false, or forged documents shall result in cancellation of hostel admission and may also lead to expulsion from the University, in accordance with the applicable rules.

5. Publication of Selection List (Provisional)

- The selection list for hostel admission shall be published on the University website on 18.08.2026.

6. Hostel Admission Fees

- Boys' Hostel: Rs. 12,000.00
- Girls' Hostel: Rs. 12,300.00

7. Validity of Hostel Admission

- Hostel admission shall be valid for one academic session only and shall not confer any right or guarantee for admission in subsequent academic sessions.

8. Refund Policy

- The hostel admission fee is non-refundable under any circumstances.

9. Mess Dues

- Monthly mess dues shall be payable separately at the hostel.

10. Residence and Attendance

- All boarders shall reside in the hostel throughout the academic session. Leave of absence exceeding seven (7) consecutive days shall ordinarily not be permitted. Every boarder shall be liable to pay the full monthly mess dues irrespective of the number of days he/she stays in the hostel during that month.

11. Maintenance of Hostel

- Every boarder shall be responsible for maintaining the cleanliness and proper upkeep of his/her room and shall cooperate in maintaining the cleanliness and hygiene of the hostel premises.
